

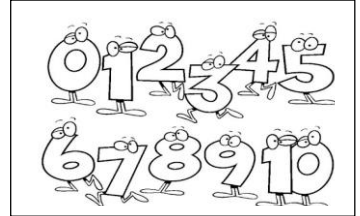
# Reception Newsletter

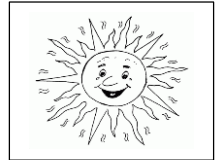
Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope you have had a good break without the stress of home-learning. We were delighted to welcome the children back after the lockdown and it is a credit to you that the children have again settled quickly into this term.

We are pleased with how children have progressed in phonics during lockdown and thank you for all your support. We attach some ideas to support children in their learning of numbers.



As the weather can be changeable please ensure your child brings a coat to school each day. As summer arrives your child will need a named sunhat and **sun cream should be applied before school**. Some sun cream can last for 8 hours, which is preferable. Should you need to send in sun cream for your child, you must complete a form (please ask a member of staff) and be mindful that your child will be encouraged to apply the sun cream by him/herself.



Please make sure that all items are named, we have noticed that some name tags have now washed off and it is impossible for us to match up unnamed garments with the right child!

## Water Bottles

Please remember to bring in a named water bottle every day. We encourage the children to drink regularly, especially in the warmer weather.
